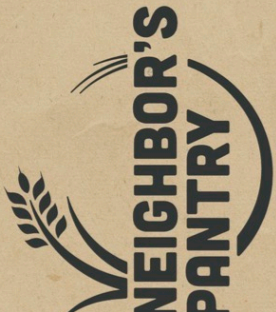
4. Neighbor's Pantry | Apr 13

Cell Group Discussion Questions

Get to Know

1. Can you identify some of the worst times of your life and some of the best times of your life? Where are you in this season?

From the Sermon

2. Reflecting on Mary Magdalene's journey from brokenness to wholeness, how does her story resonate with your own experiences of transformation or redemption?
3. Have you ever experienced a moment where you recognized Jesus' presence or voice in your life? What was that experience like??
4. Discuss the significance of Jesus commissioning Mary to share the news of his resurrection with others. How does this commissioning challenge and inspire us in our own roles as messengers of the Gospel?
5. The speaker talked about the religion of Saturday. Explain what he meant by this. Does your faith reflect Friday, Saturday, or Sunday?

Beyond the Sermon

6. Reflect on the message of Easter—the victory of life over death. How does the resurrection of Jesus Christ shape our understanding of suffering, grief, and the ultimate hope we have in Him?
