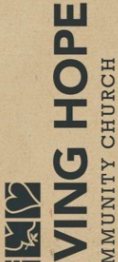

Get to Know

1. Do you process your faith more with your heart or more with your head? Can you give an example?

From the Sermon

2. Read John 20:19-31 and Luke 24:36-53. Describe the emotional and intellectual state of the disciples including Thomas.
3. What did Jesus offer to the ten disciples to help transition from fear to joy? What did Jesus offer to Thomas to help transition from disbelief to belief?
4. How did the speaker define faith and how did he differentiate it from hope?
5. Explore the distinction between intellectual and emotional faith using Thomas as an example.
6. Reflect on Thomas's confession of Jesus as "My Lord and my God." Why is this such an important confession for his faith and our faith?

7. Share whether you struggle more with emotional faith or intellectual faith. Pray for transformation on both areas.
