Cell Group Discussion Questions

Get to Know

1. Businesses often use KPI (Key Performance Indicator) as a quantifiable metrics to measure whether they are being successful. What internal KPI do you use to measure your life?

From the Sermon

2. Divide Daniel 4 into six parts: vv. 1-3, 4-12, 13-18, 19-27, 28-33, and 34-37. Have different people summarize their part for the group.
3. The speaker made a point about people seeing life as a climb up with hazards looking up and hazards looking down. Can you relate to a time when you felt pride looking down or resentment looking up?
4. C.S. Lewis mentions that being bothered by others’ pride is a sign of our own pride. Do you agree with this statement? Why or why not?
5. Nebuchadnezzar’s unique experience was that he was at the very top of the ladder, only to literally live an existence down low. Can you share a time in your life when you felt God’s intervention in a transformative way?
