## Cell Group Discussion Questions

### Get to Know

- Ice Breaker – What is something you have owned the longest and how long have you had it?

### From the Sermon

- 1) Read Daniel 6:1-28 together. What are some observations and/or questions you have about the text?
- 2) According to the speaker, what is the chiastic structure of Daniel chapters 2-7? What’s the purpose of this structure?
- 3) According to the speaker, how is Darius in chapter 6 different than Nebuchadnezzar of chapter 3, particularly the way Darius feels about punishing Daniel? (v. 16-18)
- 4) According to the speaker, rather than God’s solution to problems, what is the power of God that comforts and allows Israel to trust Him? (v.25)

### Beyond the Sermon

- 5) How would the way you look at your own current struggles if God’s response to you is His everlasting life rather than practical removal of problems? Would you be comforted when feeling anxious, angry, and afraid? Would you be able to trust God?
- 6) Reflect and journal on Philippians 2:1-11 as it talks about Christ’s humble giving of everlasting life.
