Cell Group Discussion Questions

Get to Know

1. What kind of a life did your parents live? Were they religious?

From the Sermon

2. Joshua experienced and led three distinct generations of Hebrews. Can you identify with any of the three generations in your parents, you, and your kids?
3. The second generation of Hebrews was described as competent that sometimes relied more on their abilities than on God. Is this tendency something you can relate to? How does it affect how you live the Christian life?
4. Joshua's call to the second generation in Joshua 24:14-15 was clear: choose whom you will serve. What are the "gods" in your life that compete for your devotion? How can you practically and intentionally choose to serve God during a culture that offers many alternatives?
