Cell Group Discussion Questions

GET TO KNOW

- Ice Breaker – Share about a time you got called out by your parents for breaking the rules.

FROM THE SERMON

- 1) Read 1 Samuel 2:12-36 together. What are some observations and/or questions you have about the text?
- 2) According to the speaker, how do Eli's sons' behavior reveal what they believe?
- 3) According to the speaker, why was God so angry at Eli?

BEYOND THE SERMON

- 4) If someone outside of the church were to evaluate your behaviors, what would they guess about your beliefs? What would they say is your "hypergood"?
- 5) When was a time that you shared the same space as someone but had no experience of intimacy or connection?
- 6) In what ways do you relate to Eli in your parenting? For those who aren't parents, how do you think you could be in the future?
- 7) In this season of life, what is preventing you from experiencing the witness of Jesus?
