Cell Group Discussion Questions

GET-TO-KNOW

October

Ice Breaker —"If you could instantly receive an answer from God about one question in your life right now, what would it be?"

FROM-THE-SERMON

1) Read 1 Samuel 3:1-14 together.

What are some observations and/or questions you have about the text?

2) The rarity of God's word.

Why do you think the "word of the Lord was rare" during Samuel's time? What might have caused this spiritual drought?

3) Samuel's preparation to hear God.

How did Samuel's upbringing and his location near the Ark of God (v. 3) prepare him to hear God's voice? How does this show the importance of spiritual preparation?

4) Eli's role in guiding Samuel.

Even though Eli was spiritually blind, he eventually recognized that God was calling Samuel. What does this teach us about the role of spiritual leaders, even those who may be struggling in their own faith?

5) God's message to Samuel.

Why do you think God gave such a serious message of judgment to a young boy like Samuel? How does this reveal God's expectations for obedience, even in difficult circumstances?

BEYOND-THE-SERMON

1) Listening for God's voice.

In your own life, how can you better tune your heart to listen for God's voice in times of spiritual silence or distraction?

2) Responding to God's call.

Samuel said, "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening." What practical steps can you take this week to be more responsive to God's call, especially in areas where you might be resisting?

3) Speaking truth in difficult situations.

Samuel had to deliver a hard message of judgment to Eli. Is there a situation in your life where you are being called to speak God's truth with courage? How can you prepare your heart for that?
