
### 3. Baptism | Nov 17 (Sign up by Oct 25)

### **Cell Group Discussion Questions**

### **GET-TO-KNOW**

Ice Breaker – Living Hope is celebrating 31 years as a church! What is one significant change you've experienced in your life during your time at Living Hope (or in your recent years of faith)?

### FROM-THE-SERMON

- 1. What do you notice about the way God encourages Joshua in verses 1-5? How might Joshua have been feeling during this major transition of leadership?
- Why do you think God repeats the command to "be strong and courageous" three times (verses 6, 7, 9)? What does this tell us about God's understanding of human emotions and challenges?
- 3. In verse 5, God promises Joshua, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." How does this promise connect with what you know about God's faithfulness in other parts of the Bible?
- 4. What role does remembering God's past faithfulness play in facing new challenges, according to the passage?

### **BEYOND-THE-SERMON**

- Joshua had to step into leadership during a time of great change. As you think about Living Hope's 31-year journey, how have you seen God's faithfulness through seasons of change? How does that encourage you to face personal changes in your own life?
- 2. God calls Joshua to "be strong and courageous" and to trust in His Word. What are some areas in your life right now where God is calling you to

step out in strength and courage? How can you better anchor yourself in His Word to face these challenges?

- 3. The promise of God's presence is key in this passage. How does knowing God is with you, just as He was with Joshua, shape your perspective on changes happening in your life or church today?
- 4. As Living Hope moves into its next chapter, how can we as a church continue to remember God's past blessings and trust Him for the future? What role can you play in this?
