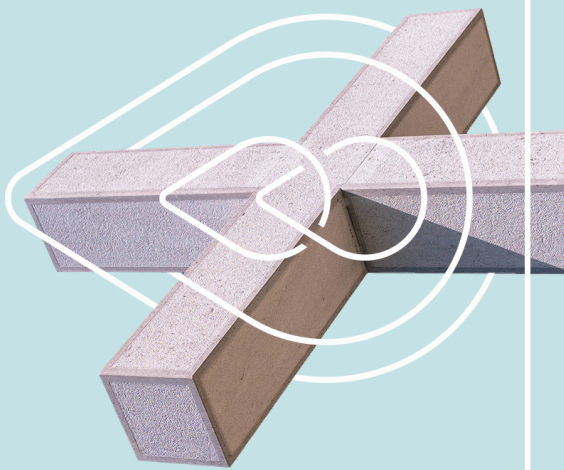

### GET-TO-KNOW

- Ice Breaker – Share a high and a low for the week.

### FROM-THE-SERMON

- 1) Read 1 Samuel 7:1-6 together. What are some observations and/or questions you have about the text?
- 2) How did the speaker summarize 1 Samuel 4 – 7? What are some details you remember about each chapter’s story?
- 3) According to the speaker, what did Israelites do wrong beyond treating God as some kind of “genie in a bottle”?
- 4) According to the speaker, how is repenting more than just saying sorry and/or feeling guilty? (7:3, 6, 9, 12, 19)

### BEYOND-THE-SERMON

- 5) What is one idol that you can or want to put away to truly repent? Think about it this week and make a plan to take action. Also, how can putting away that idol and directing your heart towards God help you to go beyond reacting to God based on your last transaction with Him? Think, pray, perhaps even journal.
