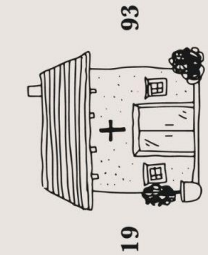

GET-TO-KNOW

- Ice Breaker – What is something that you have been “reverse engineering” in your life? How has that been going?

FROM-THE-SERMON

Read Obadiah 1:10-21 Together.

1. Biblical Prophetic Literature

The book of Obadiah is a prophetic warning against Edom. What are the three main content types of biblical prophetic literature?

2. Overview of Obadiah

Israel and Edom replay the same difficult relationship between Jacob and Esau (Gen 25+). What does Edom exactly do according to Obadiah? (v.10-14)

3. The Day of the LORD

One of the key differences between the End by God and our personal end is that God’s end includes everyone. What does Obadiah say that supports this idea? (v.19-21)

4. The Day of the LORD

The other key difference between the End by God and our personal end is that God’s end is about restoration. What does Obadiah say that supports this idea? (v.17, 18, 21)

1. For yourself:

What is something you can do this year that will make the most difference in ten years? How about in eternity?

2. As a group:

As a Cell Group, how can we support each other in reverse engineering our lives together from THE end rather than just personal desires?
