



### **GET-TO-KNOW**

 Ice Breaker – If you could immediately become really good at any hobby or profession what would you choose?

### **FROM-THE-SERMON**

- 1. According to the sermon what is the difference between being a person who is faithful vs. being a person who is full of faith? Between the two, which one do you feel like you naturally gravitate to?
