GET-TO-KNOW

- Ice Breaker - What is your first memory of hearing Jonah's story?

FROM-THE-SERMON

2. What allusions to Old and New Testament Scriptures can you spot? What do these allusions suggest to you about Jonah's story?
3. In what ways is Jesus the sign of Jonah (Matthew 12:38-42; Luke 11:29-32)?

4. Who are some "brothers" (or "enemies") in your life that God might be calling you to reach?
