


6. Volunteers Needed



Cell Group Discussion Questions

GET-TO-KNOW: Ice Breaker

If money was not a concern, what career other than your current one would you want to do?

FROM-THE-SERMON

1. Read Exodus 5:22-23. Have you ever had a time in your life where you had to pray in a similar way to God? (Questioning His decisions, doubting if you could trust him) What was the surrounding circumstance of the prayer and the result of it?
2. According to the sermon, we are called to live according to God's promises and not our own perspectives. What are some ways we can practically do that in our day to day life? What about this aspect of our journey is challenging?
3. What are some promises of God that you feel like have had a huge impact on your life? What is a promise of God you are desperate to hold onto right now?

BEYOND-THE-SERMON: Application

1. For yourself:

What is something you would want to do in your day to day life to not only be reminded of God's promises but also to train your heart/soul to trust in those promises?

2. As a group:

As a Cell Group, how can we work together to ensure that all of us are living according to God's promises and not according to our own perspectives? How do we guard our hearts from the despair, anger, anxiousness, or self-centeredness that can be spurred in our hearts if we lean on our own perspective?
