

## SERMON NOTES

“From Seed to Fruit”

Matthew 13:1-8

Yong Moon

1. \_\_\_\_\_ seeds planted will sprout and grow and bear fruit
  - a. Seed not sprouting
    - i. \_\_\_\_\_ seed
  - b. Sprouted but not lush
    - i. \_\_\_\_\_ Necessities for growth like water, sun, fertilizers
  
2. \_\_\_\_\_, we humans are the same and were given the ability to grow and bear fruit
  - a. \_\_\_\_\_ resulted in death and no life (Rom 6:23)
  - b. \_\_\_\_\_ restores life and we are once again, able to reproduce
  - c. \_\_\_\_\_ necessities for growth, we will bear fruit
  
3. Children in poverty often lack both physical and spiritual necessities for growth

Big Idea: Assess your life and growth to see if it has life and is vibrant; God can rejuvenate broken life into vibrant life, both physically and spiritually
