

## SERMON NOTES

A Vision for Home III

“A Home and Dwelling Place for God”

Ephesians 2:21-22

**Point #1 – God has always desired a \_\_\_\_\_ where His people can \_\_\_\_\_ to Him**

**A. Eden was God’s first home (temple)**

**B. Adam and Eve were God’s first priests - created to minister unto Him**

Genesis 2:15 – “The LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to ***work it*** and ***keep it.***”

**Point #2 - In the Fall, we were \_\_\_\_\_ from God’s home and lost the \_\_\_\_\_ of ministering unto Him**

Genesis 3:23-24 - “23 Therefore the Lord God sent him out from the garden of Eden to work the ground from which he was taken. 24 He drove out the man, and at the east of the garden of Eden he placed the cherubim and a flaming sword that turned every way to guard the way to the tree of life.”

**Point #3 - In Christ, God is building His home in the \_\_\_\_\_ and restoring the \_\_\_\_\_ back to them**

- **The Church is God’s temple**

Ephesians 2:21-22 – “21 in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a ***holy temple in the Lord***. 22 In him you also are being ***built together into a dwelling place for God*** by the Spirit.”

- **The Church is God’s priesthood**

1 Peter 2:9 - “9 But you are a chosen race, ***a royal priesthood***, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

Revelation 1:5-6 - “5 To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood 6 and made us a ***kingdom of priests*** to his God and Father...”

Big Idea: From the beginning of creation, God has longed for a home with us

## Cell Group Discussion Questions

### Breaking the Ice:

1. Have you ever experienced homesickness before? Can you recall a time in your life when you found yourself longing or desiring for "home"? What was that experience like?

### Digging Deeper:

**Point #1 – God has always desired a home where His people can minister to Him**

2. In this teaching, we learned that Eden was God's first home (temple) and that Adam and Eve were God's first priests. What is the primary importance of understanding this and how does this inform the way that we are to approach God in worship?

3. What would change about the way you approach Sunday worship if you came primarily to minister to God rather than to be ministered to?

**Point #2 - In the Fall, we lost access to God's home and the privilege of ministering unto Him**

4. Read Genesis 11:4. We learned that when we lose our priestly identity and calling, we start building our own temples and making worship about ourselves. What are some signs in your own heart that worship has started to become more about you than about God?

5. We also saw that there's a hidden danger when the church begins to make worship more about people than about God Himself. What are some signs that our worship has become more man-centered than God-centered?

**Point #3 - In Christ, God is building His home through the Church and restoring the priesthood back to us**

6. John Piper once said, "Missions is not the ultimate goal of the church. Worship is... Worship is ultimate, not missions, because God is ultimate, not man."

At the same time, C. S. Lewis wrote, "The Church exists for nothing else but to draw men into Christ, to make them little Christs."

As a local church family, how can we faithfully live in this tension — existing first for the worship of God, yet also called to minister to and draw people toward Him?

### Application/Challenge:

#### For Personal Worship:

7. In your personal worship this week, how can you shift your focus from "What will I get out of this?" to "How can I bless God's heart today?" What small posture or practice could help you stay centered on ministering to Him rather than receiving from Him?

#### For Corporate Worship:

8. Next Sunday, what would it look like to come to church with the heart of a priest — coming first to minister to God rather than to be ministered to? How might that mindset change the way you sing, listen, or engage during the service?
