

SERMON NOTES

A Vision for Home IV

“We are All Homebuilders”

Ephesians 4:11-16

Pastor Jeff Hyun

Point #1 – The Body of Christ is built up when each person does their part

- Ephesians 4:16 – “From whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, ***when each part is working properly,*** makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love.”

Point #2 -The Body of Christ is built up when each person exercises their gifts

- Ephesians 4:7 – “But ***grace*** was given to each one of us according to the measure of ***Christ's gift.***”

Point #3 - The goal of building up the Body of Christ is health and maturity – not just growth

- Ephesians 4:12-13 – “For building up the body of Christ, 13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to ***mature manhood,*** to the measure of the stature of the ***fullness of Christ...***”

Cell Group Discussion Questions

Breaking the Ice:

1. If you could build your dream home, what's one feature it would absolutely have? (e.g., a coffee bar, a backyard garden, a man cave, a soundproof room for the kids 😊)

Digging Deeper:

Point #1 – The Body of Christ is built up when each person does their part

2. Read Ephesians 4:16. In many churches, people assume ministry is only for pastors or leaders. How does Ephesians 4:16 challenge that mindset? Why do you think Paul insists that every part has a role in the body's growth?
3. What do you think gets in the way of believers doing their part in the body of Christ?

Point #2 - The Body of Christ is built up when every person exercises their gifts

4. Read Ephesians 4:7. Many Christians know they have spiritual gifts, but not everyone knows what theirs is. What are 1-2 spiritual gifts that you have? How have you discovered (or are still discovering) the ways God has uniquely gifted you to serve?
5. Share about a time when you used your spiritual gift — big or small — and saw it bless someone or helped build up the body of Christ.

Point #3 - The goal of building up the Body of Christ is health and maturity - not just growth

6. Read Ephesians 4:12–13. In this passage, we see that God's dream isn't just for a bigger church but for a healthier and more mature one. Based on your understanding, what are some clear signs that a church is growing in health and maturity?

Application/Challenge:

In Ephesians 4, Paul's vision for the church isn't just that we belong to the body of Christ, but that we actively build it up together. Every believer has been given a gift — a grace from Christ Himself — to help the church grow stronger, healthier, and more mature.

- What might it look like for you to take a next step in using your gifts to help build up God's home — His body, the church?
- Is there an area of ministry or need where you sense God nudging you to get involved or re-engaged?

Challenge/Invitation:
