Exodus: A New Way of Living & Being  
“Stick to the Plan”  
Exodus 6:28-7:7  
Noah Dennis

**Point #1 – God calls on \_\_\_\_\_ ...**

30 But Moses said to the Lord, “**Behold, I am of uncircumcised lips**. How will Pharaoh listen to me?” - **Exodus 6:30**

1 And the Lord said to Moses, “See, **I have made you like God to Pharaoh**, and your brother Aaron shall be your prophet. - **Exodus 7:1**

27 But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; - **1 Corinthians 1:27**

**Point #2 – ... to speak to \_\_\_\_\_ ...**

3 **But I will harden Pharaoh's heart**, and though I multiply my signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, 4 **Pharaoh will not listen to you**. - **Exodus 7:3-4a**

**Point #3 – ...in order to display the \_\_\_\_\_ .**

Then I will lay my hand on Egypt and bring my hosts, my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great acts of judgment.5 The Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord, when I stretch out my hand against Egypt and bring out the people of Israel from among them.” - **Exodus 7:4b-5**

**Big Idea: Stick to the plan! God calls on unworthy lips to speak to hard hearts in order to display the mighty hand of the Lord. So don't be discouraged by a lack of results. Live faithfully and leave the results up to God.**

## Cell Group Discussion Questions

### Icebreaker:

#1 – What is a memorable “I doubted you” moment? A moment where you doubted someone and they proved you wrong?

### Digging Deeper: [Read Exodus 6:28-7:7]

#2 – This week’s sermon reminded us that he calls on unworthy, flawed, and fragile humans to deliver his divine message.

- Where in your life are you prone to becoming most discouraged by feelings of unworthiness and inadequacies?
- God tells Moses “I have made you God to Pharaoh.” Who are you “God” to in your life? How does knowing you represent God challenge you to live?

#3 – We also learned that God will harden hearts, yet the mission continues. We are called to be faithful, not to create results.

- What often defines success for you?
- How does knowing God is in charge of creating results free you to live faithfully?
- What is an area of life that you need to keep trekking faithfully despite not seeing results?

#4 – Finally, we are reminded that the end result is that God is working to display his glory.

- Your life is a living testimony to God’s faithfulness. What is your life saying about God right now in this season?

What is one area of life that you want to keep living faithfully in or trying living faithfully in once more?
