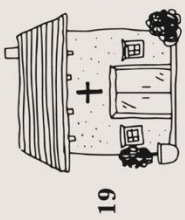
5. Facility Update

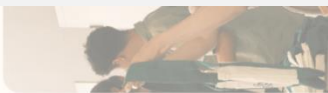
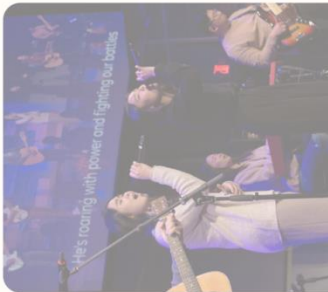

SERMON NOTES

A Vision for Home IV

“We are All Homebuilders”

Ephesians 4:11-16

Pastor Jeff Hyun

1. Hope grows in small, hidden, and unexpected places

Exodus 2:1-2 – “1 Now a man from the house of Levi went and took as his wife a Levite woman. 2 The woman conceived and **bore a son**, and when she saw that he was a fine child, **she hid him three months**.”

2. Hope is prepared in trust and sustained through surrender

Exodus 2:3a – “3 When she could hide him no longer, she took for him a **basket** made of bulrushes and daubed it with bitumen and pitch.

Exodus 2:3b – “She put the child in it and **placed it among the reeds by the river bank...**”

3. Hope is more than an experience or a feeling – it points to a person

Exodus 2:10 – “When the child grew older, she brought him to Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. **She named him Moses**, “Because,” she said, “**I drew him out of the water.**”

Matthew 2:13-15 - “13 Now when they had departed, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, “Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there until I tell you, for Herod is about to search for the child, to destroy him.” 14 And he rose and took the child and his mother by night and departed to Egypt 15 and remained there until the death of Herod. This was to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet, “**Out of Egypt I called my son.**”

Main Theme:

Hope begins in small and unexpected places, is sustained through trust and surrender, and ultimately points to the person of Jesus
