Exodus: A New Way of Living & Being
“The Way Out”
Exodus 13:17-18; 14:10-18

1. The way out begins with _____ in God’s leadership

Exodus 13:17-18 – “When Pharaoh let the people go, God did not lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near...but God led the people around by the **way of the wilderness** toward the Red Sea.”

Why the way of the wilderness?

#1 – For their protection

#2 – For their preservation (salvation)

#3 – For their formation

2. The way out will _____ our faith through crisis

Exodus 14:1-2 – “Then the Lord said to Moses, **Tell the people of Israel to turn back and encamp in front of Pi-hahiroth**, between Migdol and the sea, in front of Baal-zephon; **you shall encamp facing it, by the sea.**”

Exodus 14:10 – “10 When Pharaoh drew near, the people of Israel lifted up their eyes, and behold, **the Egyptians were marching after them**, and they feared greatly.”

When we experience a crisis of faith:

#1 - We question God’s goodness

Exodus 14:10b – “And the people of Israel **cried out to the Lord**. 11 They said **to Moses**, “Is it because there are no graves in Egypt that ***you have taken us away to die in the wilderness? What have you done to us in bringing us out of Egypt?***”

#2 - Makes Egypt look attractive

Exodus 14:12 – “Is not this what we said to you in Egypt: ‘Leave us alone that we may serve the Egyptians’? ***For it would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness.***”

3. The way out requires the intervention and help of a _____

Exodus 14:13-14 – “And Moses said to the people, ***“Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the Lord***, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again. The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to be silent.”

Exodus 14:15 – “The Lord said to Moses, ***“Why do you cry to me?*** Tell the people of Israel to go forward.”

16 Lift up your staff, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it, that the people of Israel may go through the sea on dry ground.
