6. Passion Week Outreach Trip | April 2-3

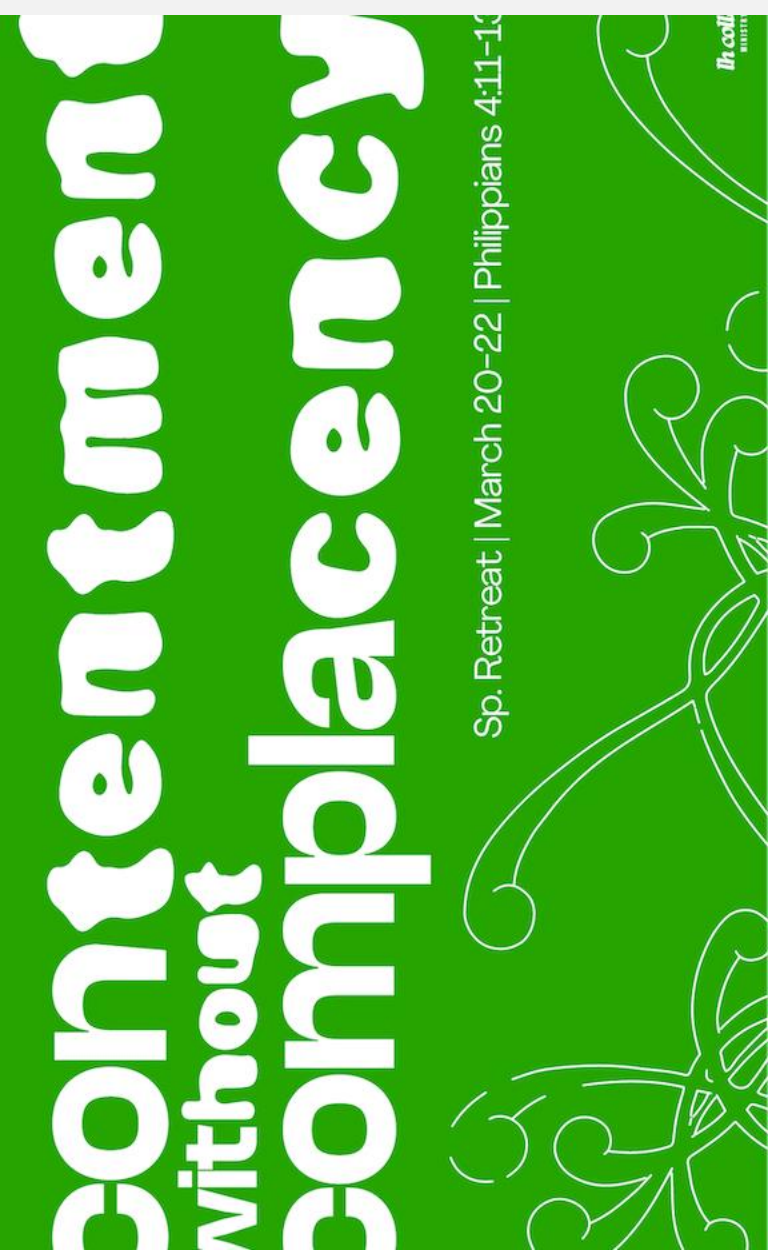
