Point #1: The Person of Prayer – Prayer is Personal and Relational

Matthew 6:9a – “Our Father in heaven...”

Point #2: The Posture of Prayer – Prayer as Reverence and Adoration

Matthew 6:9b – “Hallowed be your name...”

Point #3: The Priorities of Prayer – Prayer as Alignment and Surrender

Matthew 6:10 – “Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.”

CELL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Breaking the Ice:

- What is one word you would currently use to describe your prayer life?

Digging Deeper:

Point #1: The Person of Prayer – Prayer is Personal and Relational

- Why is Jesus' teaching us to pray to God as "Our Father" such a "revolutionary" idea? How can this challenge or change the way you personally approach God in prayer?
- When prayer feels difficult or distant, do you tend to see it more as a duty or as a relationship? What makes it feel one way or the other for you?

Point #2: The Posture of Prayer – Prayer as Reverence and Adoration

- Read Matthew 6:9b. Why is it still important to pray "hallowed be your name"? What tension does this create?

Point #3: The Priorities of Prayer – Prayer as Alignment and Surrender

- In looking at the Lord's Prayer, what stands out to you about the priorities that Jesus sets for our prayer lives (God's name, kingdom, and will)? How do these compare to what you usually pray for?
- What might it look like this week to pray "Your will be done" in a specific area of your life (work, family, relationships, decisions)?
