SERMON NOTES

A Prayer Shaped Life, Part 3

“Ask, Seek, Knock”

Matthew 7:7-11

Point #1: Pray with persistence

Matthew 7:7 – “**Ask**, and it will be given to you; **seek**, and you will find; **knock**, and it will be opened to you.

Point #2: Pray with confidence

Matthew 7:8 - “For everyone who asks **receives**, and the one who seeks **finds**, and to the one who knocks it will be **opened**.”

Point #3: Pray with trust

Matthew 7:9-11 - “Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? 10 Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? 11 If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!**”

CELL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Breaking the Ice:

- Can you think of a time when you asked for one thing, but what you received was something totally different?

Digging Deeper:

Point #1: Pray with Persistence

- Read Matthew 7:7. How does the original language of “ask,” “seek,” and “knock” point toward ongoing, persistent prayer rather than a one-time request?
- Where do you find yourself hesitant to ask God for help right now?

Point #2: Pray with Confidence

- Read Matthew 7:8. What does Jesus say here to evoke greater confidence and boldness in our prayer life?
- What is one thing that has happened in your life that has eroded confidence in prayer? In contrast, what is one thing that has happened that has boosted confidence in your prayer life and/or in God?

Point #2: Pray with Trust

- Read Matthew 7:9–11. Jesus invites us to see God as a good Father who loves to give “good gifts,” not always what we ask for. Was there ever a time in your life when God didn’t give you what you asked for, but later you realized He gave you something better?
- Which of the three - persistence, confidence, or trust - do you find most difficult in your prayer life right now?

PRAYER PRACTICE FOR THE WEEK:

Asking God Together

This week’s practice invites you to bring your needs honestly before God and to trust Him with both the timing and the outcome.

Step 1: Name Your Request

Take a moment to name one specific area where you are asking God for help, guidance, or change - for yourself, your family, or someone you love. In naming your request before God, we encourage you to submit a prayer request form so our leadership can pray for you:

Step 2: Pray With Trust

Pray simply and honestly: “Father, You know what I need. I trust You with this request and with how You choose to answer.” Release the outcome into God’s hands.

Step 3: Pray Together

This will be a special extended prayer gathering where our elders, pastors, and ministry directors will be available to pray for you and your family. Come to receive prayer, worship together, and let’s seek God together as a church family - whether you are celebrating answered prayers or waiting faithfully.
