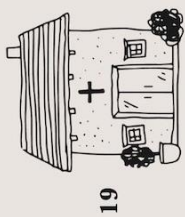

1. Covenant Document: The Ten Commandments is a covenant document for a newly formed people of God.

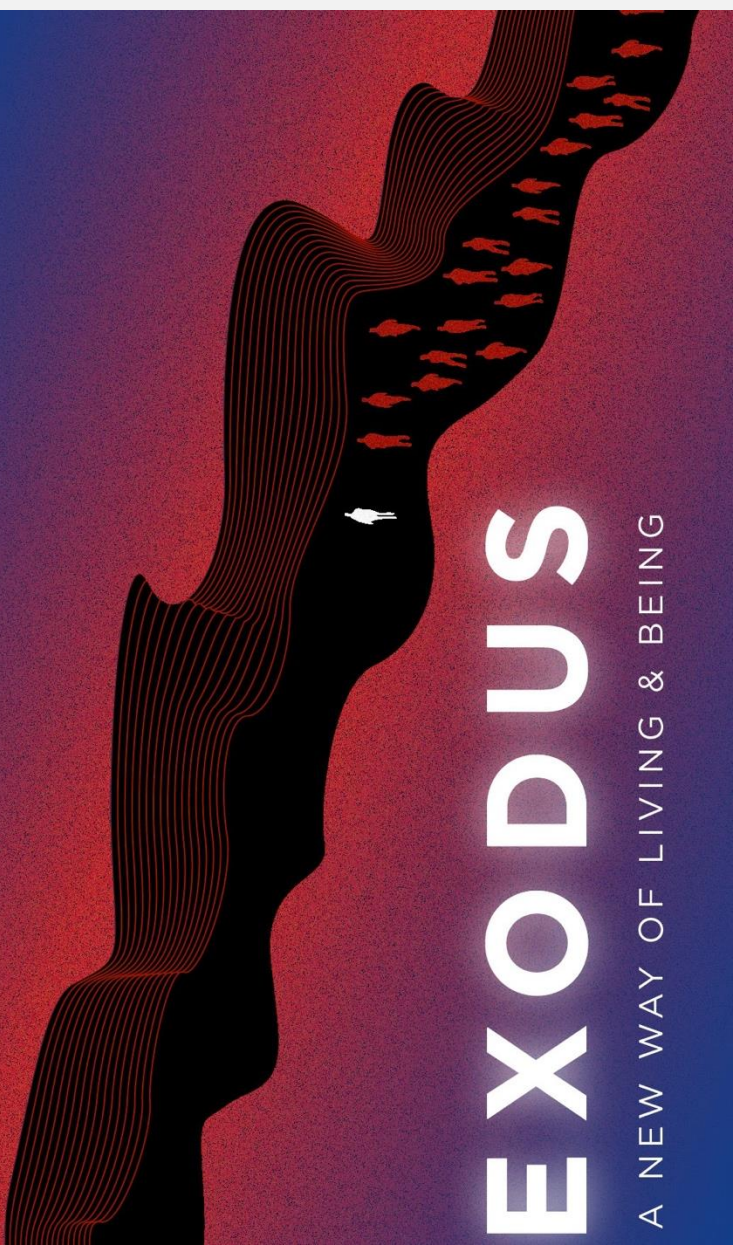
2. The first and last commandments are bookends to the commandments. It gives context to the other commandments.

Exodus 20:2,17

3. Jesus and the Ten Commandments: Jesus fulfills the law by obeying the law perfectly for us.

CELL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Breaking the Ice:

- Which commandment do you struggle with the most, and what makes it challenging?

Digging Deeper:

Point #1: How does understanding the Ten Commandments as a covenant document shape your perspective on them?

- Beginning with the covenant name Yahweh, the document reveals its personal nature. Our obedience flows not just from the truth of the commandments, but from the One who commanded them. Does this change how you see them—as arbitrary rules or as a loving God's guidance?
- Knowing the Ten Commandments are a loving self-communication from the Lord to His chosen people helps us walk in obedience."

Point #2 – The New Testament (Col. 3:5) equates covetous with idolatry. Idolatry is usually a “good” thing that becomes an ultimate thing.

- I John 5:21
 - John, in a brief statement, is expressing in negative terms what he had spent the whole letter putting in the positive. This must mean that the only way to walk in holiness, love and truth is to keep free from idols.
- What idols are you holding onto in your heart?
 - What are some practical ways to spot those idols?

Point #3 - Jesus fulfills the law by obeying the law

- We tend to think of the law as rules to obey, but Jesus sees the law as something to fulfill.
- What is the “first and greatest commandment” How did Jesus fulfill it?
- How did Jesus deepen the first commandment as he fulfilled it?

Closing Application & Prayer:

Finish by praying together over the specific areas where you find yourself struggling with idols.
