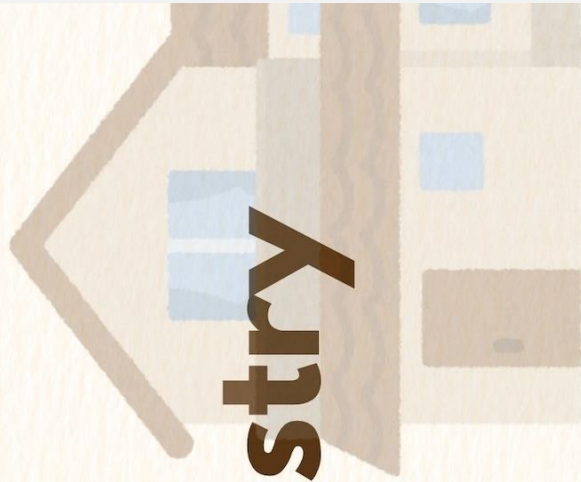

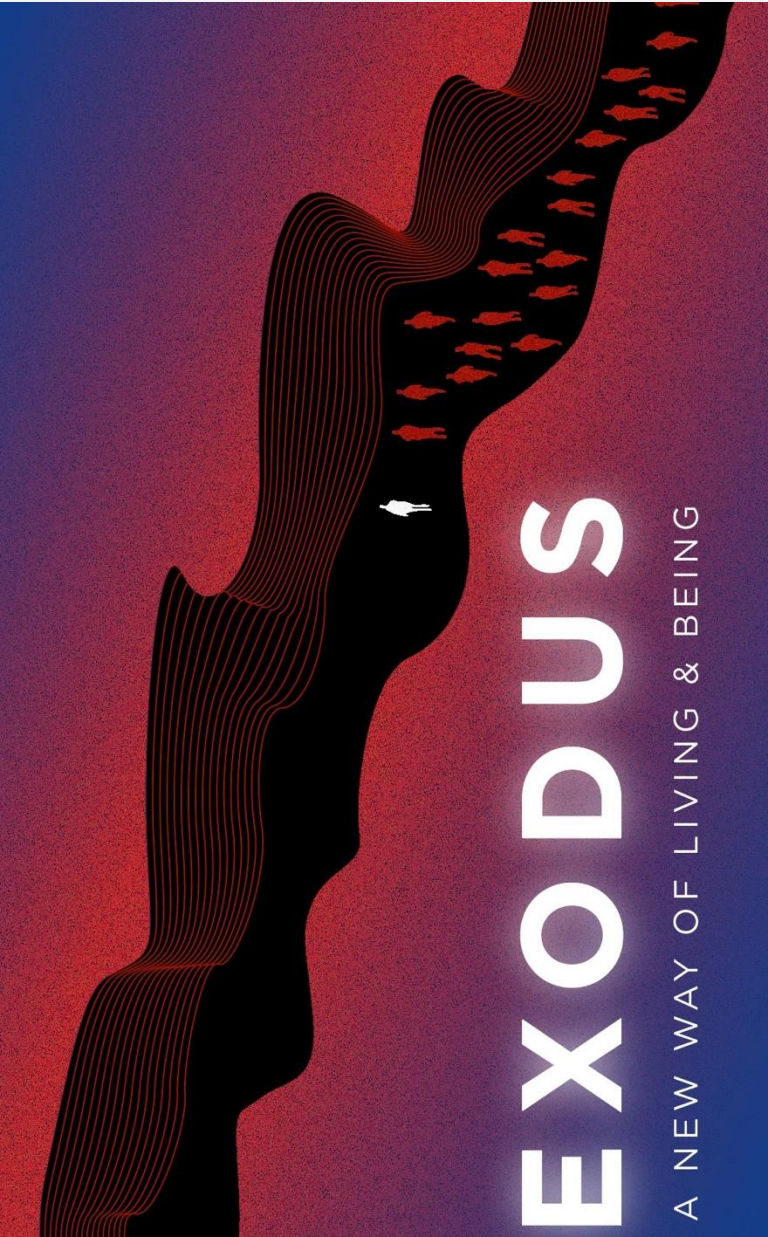

CELL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Breaking the Ice:

1. Watch the following video and share your thoughts about the theme of this spoken word presentation:

Digging Deeper:

Point #1: Clothes that reveal

2. Read Exodus 28:1-4. The clothes are described as “holy garments” for “glory and beauty.” The priests also bear the names of the tribes of Israel and the name of God Himself. What do these descriptors say about the role of the priest?
3. The priestly garments are like an inside-out tabernacle as if to showcase what’s in the Holy of Holies. How does the priest point to the original design of humans, made in the “image of God”?

Point #2: Clothes that cover up

4. Read Exodus 28:29-38. What do you think it means that the priest bears the judgment and guilt of the people?
5. Read Zechariah 3. What does this passage imply about the priestly system’s ability (or lack of ability) to cleanse and atone?

Point #3: Clothes that are torn

6. Read Exodus 28:42-43 and Leviticus 16. Why do you think the priests go into the Holy of Holies without the robe and only the linen undergarments?
7. What is the significance of Jesus’ baptism, crucifixion and resurrection where he lays aside his clothes or is stripped of them? How do these scenes reveal the true nature of Jesus as both God and human?

Personal Reflection:

8. If Jesus not only reveals to us what it means to be God but also what it means to be human, then how does that shape how you understand your worth/value?
9. Are there “clothes” that you need to lay aside? What do you use to cover up your shame or sense of lack?
10. How does recognizing the sacredness of every human change the way you encounter the other?
