OUR PROMISE

We promise an immersive ministry experience to help interns discern their calling. Interns will receive:

- **PRACTICAL TRAINING** – Hands-on ministry experience in their track.
- **PERSONAL MENTORSHIP** – One-on-one mentoring with a pastoral leader in their track.
- **PUBLIC AFFIRMATION** – Recognition as a ministry candidate within our affiliated networks.

OUR PARTICULARS

Responsibilities

The intern is expected to be a fully participating pastoral staff member of Living Hope Community Church in areas such as:

- Regular attendance at Sunday services, major events, and small groups
- Attendance at pastoral staff meetings and other required meetings
- Participate in monthly coaching sessions
- Hours: approximately 15 hours/week

Benefits

- Wage & Access to Seminary Scholarships
- 10 days of paid time off, of which only three can be used on Sundays

Timetable

- The internship shall last twelve months (September 1, 2026 – August 31, 2027).

OUR PROCESS & PRE-REQUISITES

To apply for the Living Hope Internship:

- Applicants must be at least a college junior and be considering a calling as a vocational pastor/director in the respective track.
 - The Pastoral Ministry Track requires a completed seminary degree or enrollment in one.
- Complete the application and send it to the relevant track contact (see above) and Pastor Ervin.
- Have an interview with the pastoral mentor of the track you have selected.
- Applications are accepted on a rolling basis and close on July 1st, or when filled.
