The Church in Ephesus (like Living Hope) was/is...

#1 – A hardworking, faithfully _____ church

Revelation 2:2 – “I know your works, your toil...”

#2 – A _____ and resilient church

Revelation 2:2 – 2 “I know your works, your toil and your patient endurance...”

Revelation 2:3 – 3 “I know you are enduring patiently and bearing up for my name's sake, and you have not grown weary.”

#3 – A church that was faithful to the _____ and to the _____

Revelation 2:2b – 2 “I know...how you cannot bear with those who are evil, but have tested those who call themselves apostles and are not, and found them to be false.”

Despite all these positive things – the church in Ephesus had moved away from one key thing:

Revelation 2:4 – 4 But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first.

Remember that the church in Ephesus was a church that was commended for their love:

Ephesus 6:24 – “24 Grace be with all who love our Lord Jesus Christ with love incorruptible.”
