SERMON NOTES

“Coram Deo: Before the Face of God”

Exodus 33:12-23

Pastor Jeff Hyun

Point #1 – To live before the face of God means to live under the unmerited grace and favor of God

Exodus 33:15 – “And he said to him, “If your **presence** will not go with me, do not bring us up from here.”

Number 6:24-26 – “The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his **face** to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up his **countenance** upon you and give you peace.

Point #2 – To live before the face of God is to hunger to know God more fully and intimately

Exodus 33:11 – “Thus the Lord used to speak to Moses **face to face**, as a man speaks to his friend.”

Exodus 33:20 – “‘But’, He said, ‘**you cannot see my face**, for man shall not see me and live.’”

Exodus 33:18 – “Moses said, ‘**Please show me your glory.**’”

Point #3 – To live before the face of God is to behold the Son of God – Jesus Christ.

Exodus 33:18 – “Moses said, ‘**Please show me your glory.**’”

Exodus 33:21-23 – “21 And the Lord said, “Behold, there is a place by me where you shall stand on the rock, 22 and while my glory passes by I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and I will cover you with my hand until I have passed by. 23 Then I will take away my hand, and **you shall see my back**, but **my face shall not be seen.**”

2 Corinthians 4:6 – “For God, who said, “Let light shine out of darkness,” has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God **in the face of Jesus Christ.**”

Read Exodus 33:7. Why does the author go to painstaking detail to show that the Tent of Meeting was located way outside of the camp?

Read Hebrews 7:25. Jesus “always lives to make intercession” for us. If Jesus is praying for you right now, what do you imagine He is praying over you in this season of your life?
