Prelude

Call to Worship | From Psalm 100 & Ephesians 2

LEADER: Make a joyful noise to the LORD, all the earth! Serve the LORD with gladness! Come into his presence with singing!

ALL: Know that the LORD, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

LEADER: Remember that you were at that time separated from Christ and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world...But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

Corporate Confession of Sin

Personal Confession of Sin

Assurance of Pardon | John 3:16-18a

[16] “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. [17] For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. [18] Whoever believes in him is not condemned.

Affirmation of Faith | Heidelberg Catechism Q. 1

LEADER: What is your only comfort in life and death?

PEOPLE: *That I am not my own, but belong—body and soul, in life and in death, to my faithful Savior Jesus Christ. He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil. He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven: in fact, all things must work together for my salvation. Because I belong to him, Christ, by his Holy Spirit, assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.*
