A New Definition of the Dog Days of Summer

I must admit that when I arrived at LOPC three months ago, I never expected that I would need a month off to recover from Covid. But, then the providence of God can be surprising and is always good. This has been a very challenging time for Evie and me, but in the midst of it all we have so much to be thankful for.

Let me brag on this congregation for a moment. You all have been incredible. From the prayers and cards to the emails and calls and meals, we have been lavished with nothing but love and support. As frustrated as I have been to be absent from you, you have made it clear that we are not in control and that we are loved. Your love has been incredible.

The second thing this trial has reminded me of is my profound weakness. In 2 Corinthians 12, Paul is praying to the Lord about his thorn in the flesh. And this is the Lord's response to him. "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong."

Now, I would love to tell you that I have it all together when it comes to cultivating this passage in my life. But I have a confession to make: nothing is harder for me than admitting my weakness. Asking for help, feeling like I'm disappointing people, being frustrated with myself - these are all signs that I have a long way to go in my Christian growth.

It is in the midst of the depth of these struggles that the Lord's precious promise becomes more and more real. His grace is sufficient for me, for his power is made complete in my weakness. Wow! The Lord and his grace is always so counter-intuitive to how I most naturally think and feel. I always feel like I need to measure up and be good enough, and yet the Lord says that life in Christ is completely based on the opposite premise: that I am not good enough, I don't measure up, but Jesus is, and I am in him. I am seen and treated by the Father in Christ. So, Jesus is good enough, and I am in him. Oh, the wonder of God's grace.

This is not what I intended for my summer. But it is exactly what the Lord had planned for me, and thus for us as his people. Praise the Lord that his grace is sufficient.

They minister to this community through helping meet felt needs in areas of English language, after school tutoring and citizenship. Through this outreach, God has opened the hearts and minds of a number of people who now worship Him in a local Bangladeshi underground church. Jim and Carin have one son (Nathan) who is a rising junior at Covenant College.

Sheds of HOPE

The LOPC Sheds of HOPE ministry fundraiser will continue through August, but thanks to God's grace and your generous giving so far, we're confident that we'll reach our \$25,000 goal and we'll be able to continue building sheds this fall.

Our next shed build is scheduled for September 20 – 23. We're planning to build 4 sheds, as usual. Whether the sheds will go into storage at the MNA Disaster Response warehouse in Rome, GA or directly to a disaster site will depend on the timing of this year's storms.

We're planning another Youth shed build October 14 – 18. We'll welcome middle and high schoolers from the LOPC Youth Group and our community to join us for this weekend build, which will be our second Youth build in 2021. If you're in the 6th grade or higher, we hope you'll plan to join us for the fun!

We're expecting some visitors from other churches to join us for our November 15 – 19 shed build. They'll work alongside us, learn how to build sheds and use what they learn to build another Sheds of HOPE team at their home church. We enjoy meeting fellow Christians, making new friends and growing the Sheds of HOPE ministry.

Sheds of HOPE provides free dry storage sheds to families who have lost their homes to disasters such as floods, tornadoes, fires, and hurricanes. To date, **over 100 sheds have been given to families** throughout the southeast, including Eatonton!



With the inflation of building materials, the cost of each shed has nearly doubled. LOPC Sheds of HOPE needs your help to raise **\$25,000 by the end of August 2021** to fund the remaining 12 sheds in 2021 and provide funds to begin building sheds in 2022.

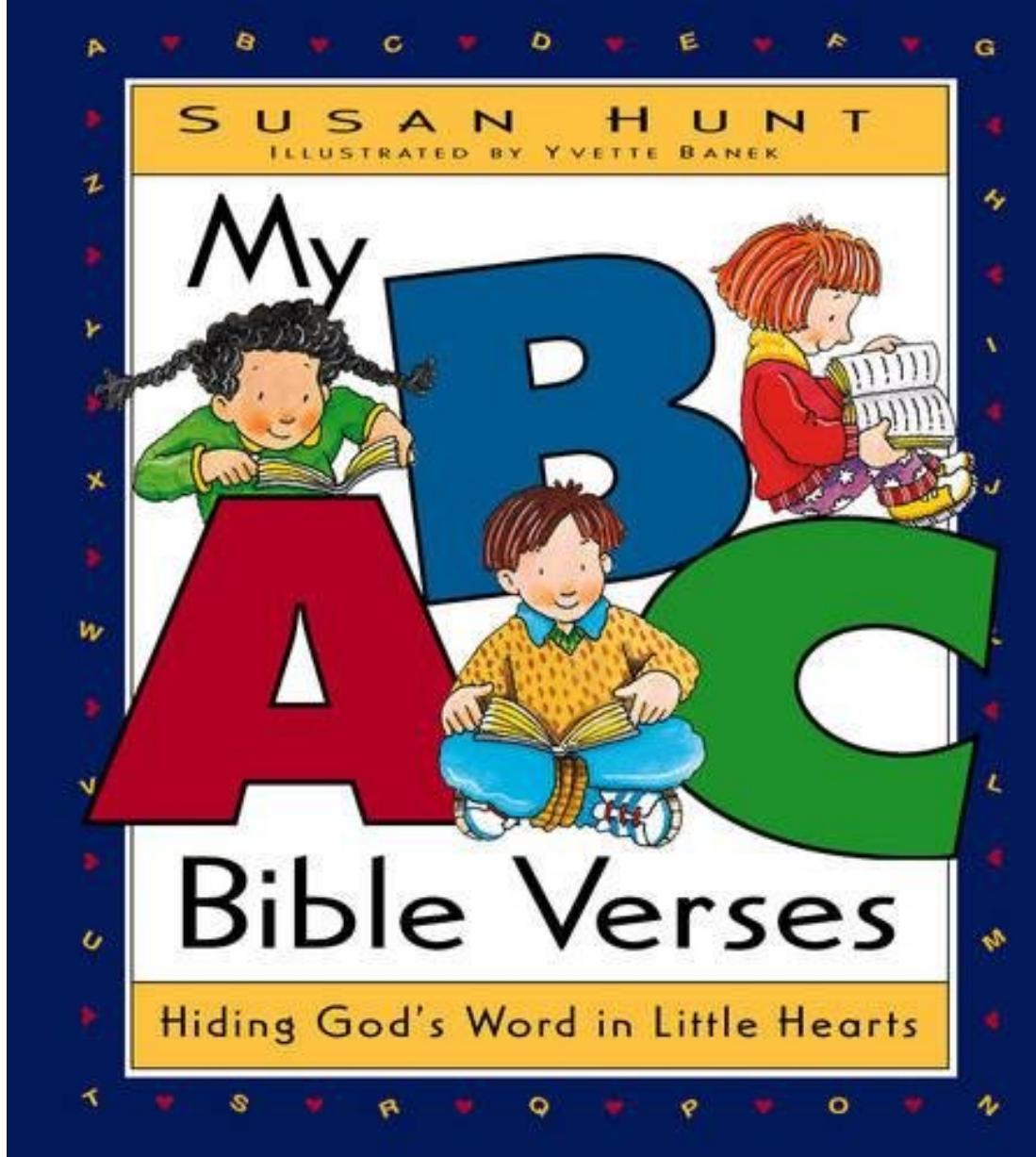
