What Do We Really Need?

February is Valentine's Day, and truth be told, I struggle with Valentine's Day. Why do I struggle with it? Because I am not a very romantic person. Evie is such a better gift giver than I am. She is so creative, and she is always coming up with things that surprise me. While I, on the other hand, have never been able to pull off a surprise on her. Valentine's Day can be a struggle for other reasons as well. It can be a time of incredible loneliness or sadness, wishing things were different, missing a loved one, or just not having the love in our life that we so crave and long for.

I get that, and that is why these made-for-Hallmark type holidays can be such a mixed bag. But they can also be a time where we reflect and are renewed in what we truly need and what we have in Christ. The apostle Paul, in his letter to the Ephesians, sums up very well in his prayer for the church what our heart truly needs. Listen to the text.

"For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, that according to the riches of his glory

he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith – that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen" (Ephesians 3:14-21).

Now, think about this. This is Paul's prayer for the church. He could have prayed for so many things for the church. He could have prayed for power in witness or safety from enemies, or for our families to be blessed. All good things. But what does he pray for? For us to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge. Incredible! What is our greatest need? Apparently, it is for us to know more deeply, more profoundly, the love of Christ.

In fact, that is why, earlier in the prayer, Paul asks that we would be strengthened in our inner being so that Christ would be able to dwell within us. Again, apparently, we can't handle the love of Christ. Our inner beings are too weak. We need spiritual strength to be able to cultivate the breadth, length, height and depth of His love.

Lastly, look at how Paul concludes his prayer. He concludes with this amazing promise that God is able to do far more abundantly than we could ever ask or imagine. Now, we all too often totally misconstrue this promise. We think about it circumstantially. I have this particular need and God is able to do far more abundantly than we could ask or imagine. Then, if he doesn't answer the prayer the way we would like we get disappointed or disillusioned. But look at what this is promising. The text says that we may be filled with all the fullness of God, and that is what God is able to do far more abundantly than we could ever ask or imagine.

But and here is the crucial question. Is that what we want? Do you hear that and read this text and kind of say to yourself, "Oh yeah, well, whatever, that's great, but I would rather have" fill in the blank? Maybe we need a sort of adjustment of perspective?


Listen to how Tim Keller puts it: "All Christians are filled with the fullness of God. This petition, if you think about it brings a lot of confusion. Paul is praying for things that are already true. Or is he? What is going on here? The only way to understand what he is saying is this: If it is really true that all Christians have Christ dwelling in their hearts by faith, then he must be saying that it is one thing to have money in the bank, but it is another thing to draw it. You can have a billion dollars and live poor. So, it is one thing to have Christ living in your heart, but it is another thing to experience it. It is one thing to have the fullness of God in your life it is another thing to actually experience it. And he is saying therefore something important, something enormously important. He is saying there is something possible that you have not begun to tap. And if you are a Christian you must realize that. There are always these two sides. You can have Christ living in you and not experience it. You can have the fullness of God and not experience it. Here is Paul praying that you will know it. Why? We know but we don't

know. Every Christian knows that God loves them, but yet he is praying that we will know the love of God. You know but you don't know; you think you know but you don't know. You will never get anywhere near the experience of God until the first thing you do is to bow your head and you say I haven't the slightest idea what these words mean; I have hardly ever tapped; I have tasted four drops out of the ocean. That is the reality of Christian experience."

Yes, Valentine's Day can be hard. Or it can be great. We don't minimize the difficulty, nor do we gloss over the joy. Whichever it is, let us recognize our truest need: to experience the love of Christ and to tap into the fullness of God that is ours through our union with Jesus Christ.






