Assurance of Pardon | 1 Peter 2:24-25

24 He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed. **25** For you were straying like sheep, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

Affirmation of Faith | Heidelberg Catechism Question 43

Question - What benefit do we receive from Christ's sacrifice and death on the cross?

Answer - By His power our old man is crucified, put to death, and buried with Him, so that the evil desires of the flesh may no longer rule us, but that instead we may offer ourselves as a sacrifice of thanksgiving to Him.
