Are you an adult who is passionate about passing the faith on to the next generation? Please consider being part of the Prayer Partner Program. This program will match a child or youth (birth through high school age) with an adult in the congregation in order to provide the child with another adult in their life, other than their parents and relatives, who knows their name, cares about them, assures them they are not alone facing day-to-day challenges, and makes them

feel that they matter by promising to pray faithfully for them. It will involve regularly asking your partner, or their parents in the case of very young children, for prayer requests. Prayer partner matches will be made based on availability. The commitment is intended to last for one year but may continue longer, if desired. Once the adults have signed up, kids will be matched with an adult of the same gender, and we will have a get-acquainted lunch after church where adults and children can learn a little about each other. If you haven't completed a background check at LOPC, contact the church office to get that simple process started. Our kids are valuable to God and are worth the investment!
