Food Service Assistant Job Description

Department: Operations

Reports to: Lead Cook/Food Service Coordinator

Type of Position: Part-time, seasonal, 15 – 25 hrs/week

General Description: The Food Service Assistant generally provides assistance to the lead cooks and food service coordinator in preparing and serving a top-quality dining experience to our guests and campers.

Duties and Responsibilities

Inventory:

- Checks in deliveries, stocks pantry, cooler and freezer using FIFO (first-in, first-out) method
- 2. Conducts physical inventory as requested by the Food Service Coordinator
- 3. Pulls stock as needed for food preparation

Food Preparation:

- 1. Assists cooks with variety of tasks including but not limited to:
 - a. Salad bar prep
 - b. Panning products for baking
 - c. Opening cans and boxes
 - d. Making Kool-aid and filling beverage dispensers
 - e. Checking and filling coffee machines

Cleaning:

- 1. Washes dishes, pots, pans, and utensils throughout the shift using the dish machine and 3-compartment sink
- 2. Cleans and sanitizes preparation areas between tasks (work tables, counters, floors)
- 3. Sweeps and mops kitchen and storage areas daily
- 4. Sweeps walk-in coolers and freezer daily
- 5. Cleans and sanitizes serving tables and steam tables after each meal
- 6. Performs deep cleaning tasks as assigned by the Food Service Coordinator

Such other duties and responsibilities as requested by the Food Service Coordinator or Operations Director
