General Description: Housekeeping staff are responsible for keeping our grounds, buildings and equipment welcoming and visually pleasing to help the ministry and operations of Camp Manitoqua & Retreat Center.

Duties and Responsibilities

Cleaning:

- 1. Clean, sanitize, dust and maintain all buildings owned and operated by Camp Manitoqua
- 2. Wash, sanitize and properly store bed and bath linens
- 3. Keep paper towels, toilet tissue, soap, facial tissues and other supplies in restrooms, sleeping and meeting rooms filled
- 4. Notify Housekeeping Coordinator of maintenance requests and supply needs
- 5. Provide support to all facilities and grounds volunteer groups as needed
- 6. Keep work area and tools clean and organized.
- 7. General upkeep of facilities and grounds, trouble shoot and repair minor issues

General:

- 1. Ensure all doors are locked and that buildings are left in a safe and secure condition at the end of workday
- 2. Work cooperatively with team leader
- 3. Provide support to all facilities and grounds volunteer groups as needed
- 4. Work independently on the task given.
- 5. Recognize when a task is above your skill level.
