Maintenance Staff Job Description

Department: Facilities

Reports to: Facilities Coordinator

Type of Position: Part-time

General Description: Maintenance staff are responsible for keeping our grounds, buildings, and equipment functioning, welcoming and visually pleasing to help the ministry and operations of Camp Manitogua & Retreat Center.

Duties and Responsibilities

Grounds care:

- 1. Mow lawns.
- 2. Edge and sweep areas around sidewalks, landscaping, and buildings.
- 3. Fuel and operate required tools and machinery to get the job done.
- 4. Move items to cut under and/or pick up sticks and garbage as needed.

Maintenance:

- 1. Keep work area and tools clean and organized. Troubleshoot and repair minor issues, including general upkeep of facilities and grounds.
- 2. Perform general maintenance on vehicles.
- 3. Safely operate equipment for cleaning and maintenance.
- 4. Carry & lift equipment into vehicles and golf carts.

General:

- 1. Ensure all doors are locked and that buildings are left in a safe and secure condition at the end of workday
- 2. Work cooperatively with team leader
- 3. Provide support to all facilities and grounds volunteer groups as needed
- 4. Work independently on the task given.
- 5. Recognize when a task is above your skill level.

1. Make every effort to build up the community of the staff and to increase understanding among all staff members.
