Position Summary

The Nurse Assistant position is responsible for the health and safety of all campers, staff, and other camp personnel including medications and first aid.

Qualifications:

- Strong desire and ability to care for, love, teach, and work with children and staff in a camp setting
- Actively pursuing personal Christian growth
- Skills in interpersonal relationships, communication, and supervision
- Nursing student or in related field
- Completed first round of clinicals
- First Aid and CPR certified

Responsibilities and Expectations

- Attend coordinator and staff orientation
- Reside in assigned staff housing
- Review with Nurse all campers, summer staff, SAMs, and weekly volunteer's medical release forms. Compile notes for appropriate staff.
- Assist with camper check-ins and collection of medications
- Assist Nurse in a weekly inspection of camp facilities, reporting all items that do not meet health and safety standards
- Assist with organizing medications for the week
- Distribute and give medications as scheduled
- Maintain some office hours for consultation with campers and staff
- Administer first aid when appropriate
- Take campers or staff to the clinic or hospital as needed
- Keep accurate daily records for all treatments, consultations, clinic visits and any other health incidents
- Stay with any sick or injured camper as needed, including possible night duty
- Inspect and stock all First Aid kits

- Inventory all supplies and equipment throughout summer
- Oversee the health standards of summer staff and housing issues
- Responsible for clear communication with families regarding health situations specific to their child
- Be on call for REZ at night
- Welcome all campers upon their arrival
- Prepare and lead Bible lessons, devotions, games and activities (may also be assigned to lead an area that requires specific skills)
- Be prepared with the necessary materials for each day
- Lead activities within the structure outlined in the program and policies and procedures manual of Camp Manitoqua
- Be present at all required camp sessions, campfires, and meals for active participation, prayerful support, and crowd control
- Care for the spiritual, emotional, and physical health and safety of all campers and staff with energy and compassion
- Help develop a family and greater community environment with in day camp groups including good behavior management practices
- Be an advocate for community with staff
- Be able to share the gospel with anyone and seek opportunities to do so
- Be committed to the study of God's word and prayer for campers and staff
- Attend the all staff debriefs on Friday afternoons at 5pm
- Attend the all staff prebriefs on Sundays: small groups and announcements at 6pm; and staff worship at 7pm
- Attend the Staff Retreat and Staff Party
- Present a full evaluation of personal performance and camp operations at the close of summer
- Perform other duties as requested by the Program Coordinator
- Be familiar with Manitoqua Ministries, its mission, purpose, guidelines, and policies as outlined in the staff manual
