8:00	Breakfast	
8:00	Open Activities	early morning activities such as hikes, polar plunges, devotions by campfire, or some extra sleep
9:00	Chapel	high energy celebration of God and His character led by our summer chaplain with songs, skits, dramas, dynamic messages, and small group discussions
10:00	Focus Groups	campers explore interests in one of the following areas: art, drama, outdoor camping, or sports
11:00	Cabin Activities	all-camp games, guy time/girl time, or stewardship activities
12:00	Lunch	
1:00	Open Activities	new or continued activities, such as a quick game of frisbee golf or finishing an art project
2:00	Family Time	events where cabins are challenged to work together at the adventure zone, tree climbing, paintballing course, or dirtboarding course. also includes horseback riding
2:40	Quiet Time	20 minutes set aside every day for quiet, personal devotions, prayer, reading, or journaling
3:00	Free Time	time set aside for campers to visit either the aquatic center, game room, pickle shack, camp store, pond, or art hut; all areas are supervised by Manitoqua summer staff and camp lifeguards
5:00	Devotions & Cabin Calls	
5:30	Dinner	
6:00	Cabin Time	activities that develop community such as: arts and crafts, team building exercises, games, rafting, or the giant slip-n-slide
7:00	Chapel	high energy celebration of God and His character led by our summer Chaplain with songs, skits, dramas, dynamic messages, and small group discussions
8:00	Evening Camp Celebration	may include: large group games, campfires, pool parties, skits, and much more
9:00	Snack Attack	all out blast of limbo, karaoke, dancing, hanging out, and of course, sweet and salty snacks
10:00	Cabin Devo's & Lights Out	debriefing and continued discussions on chapel messages
