On September 29, we will meet for a brief worship service at 8:30 a. m., then go to various places in our community to serve as part of Big Serve V. This is the perfect opportunity for you to put service into practice.

Our calling as Christians is not just to care for one another within the church but also to extend God's love and grace to those beyond our doors. In line with God's vision, we continue to focus on how we can reach out and make a tangible difference in the lives of others.

I am excited about what God is doing in and through Maples Memorial UMC, and I look forward to seeing how we can continue to grow together as a Church that shines His light in the world.
