
Let Us Encourage One Another

Hebrews 3:12-13

12 Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. 13 But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

The Book of Hebrews was written to a group of primarily Jewish believers in Jesus who are feeling the pressure—outright persecution to turn away from following Jesus. This document is a call to perseverance in the face of ongoing difficulties, temptations, and trials.





"to come alongside someone to encourage them, to urge, to console, to cheer up, to invite or to summon"



My self-perception is as accurate as a carnival mirror. If I am going to see myself clearly, I need you to hold the mirror of God's Word in front of me.


