

Now is the time to make real the promise of democracy. Now is the time to rise from the dark and desolate valley of segregation to the sunlit path of racial justice. Now is the time to lift our nation from the quicksand of racial injustice to the solid rock of brotherhood. Now is the time to make justice a reality to all God's children....

There are those who are asking the devotees of civil rights, "When will you be satisfied?" We can never be satisfied as long as the Negro is the victim of the unspeakable horrors of police brutality. We can never be satisfied as long as our bodies, heavy with the fatigue of travel, cannot gain lodging in the motels of the highways and the hotels of the cities.

We cannot be satisfied as long as the Negro's basic mobility is from a smaller ghetto to a larger one. We can never be satisfied as long as our children are stripped of their selfhood and robbed of their dignity by signs stating "for whites only"....

No, no we are not satisfied and we will not be satisfied until justice rolls down like waters and righteousness like a mighty stream.

Men you dream of this world becoming a better place, what does that loop like?

I must preach the good years of the kingdom of God... Jesus of Nazareth





Jesus implied that his disciples would be driven to desperation as they endured the pressures, assaults, and opposition of the world around them...

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So the prayer Jesus speaks of is particularly prayer that goes on pleading with God to put things right for His people as they suffer wrong in this world.

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Jesus assumes that you will likely have trouble with prayer.... This statement recognizes that there are times when prayer will be hard, when will be tempted to leave off praying and give it all up....

There may be times when we have no emotional energy, no warmth of feeling, for prayer. A creeping conviction of pointlessness slithers into our mind, and we find our motivation has sprung a slow leak.

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But Jesus says his disciples '*must* always pray.' So this is where what I call 'Anyway Christianity' has to kick in. You don't feel like praying; you may imagine it's useless to do so, but you do it anyway.

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

You do it because Jesus says so. His disciples *'must* always pray.' There is often simply a certain doggedness about the Christian life.

2 He said, "In a certain city there was a judge who neither feared God nor respected man...." Jehoshaphat... appointed judges in the land. He told them, "Consider carefully what you do, because you are not judging for mere mortals but for the Lord, who is with you whenever you give a verdict. Now let the fear of the Lord be on you. Judge carefully, for with the Lord our God there is no injustice or partiality or bribery."

2 He said, "In a certain city there was a judge who neither feared God nor respected man...."

3 And there was a widow in that city who kept coming to him and saying, "Give me justice against my adversary." 4 For a while he refused, but afterward he said to himself, 'Though I neither fear God nor respect man, 5 yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will give her justice, so that she will not beat me down by her continual coming.



He never gave her the time of day. But after this went on and on he said to himself, 'I care nothing what God thinks, even less what people think. But because this widow won't quit badgering me, l'd better do something and see that she gets justiceotherwise I'm going to end up beaten black and blue by her pounding.'



We continue to pray not because we are trying to get God's attention, but because we already have it!




My Best Shot at the Sense of This:



FOCUS•ON•THE•BIBLE

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We must remember Jesus' whole purpose in telling this parable. And we must remember the kind of prayer he speaks of – not prayer for a new job or for your house to sell, for your kid to get accepted into a certain university, but for God to give justice to his weary and beaten-down people.

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God's people live in a world in which they are assailed, assaulted, and sometimes annihilated, and so, in the face of that, they must never give in, lose heart, or throw in the towel; they must keep praying for God to put things right. And this prayer requires unrelenting tenacity.

When we pray longing prayers for the coming of God's kingdom, our hearts are actually reflecting the longing heart of God!

Let's remember that we have every reason to pray and not lose heart!

Your kingdom come!


O Lord, have mercy!

Prayer is the expression of our powerlessness and our dependence on God, and at the same time the most powerful means we have of collaborating in God's work.





God does not bring the kingdom independently of his people, but through his people as they trust him and express that trust in prayer. Prayer is thus a top priority in the revolution of God.



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
Let's trust in God's perfect timing.
