It's news about what Jesus has done in his life, death, & resurrection to offer us both the forgiveness of sins & eternal life.





...that the Christ must suffer and that, by being the first to rise from the dead, he would proclaim light both to our people and to the nations.



Paul has now spent at least 4 YEARS in prison, and now he is awaiting Caesar's decision. Will he be executed or set free?


Nero Reigned from AD54-AD68



The Imperial Guard was a unit of some 9,000 soldiers trusted with the task of guarding the Roman Emperor & his palace. The soldiers were used, of course, to the 'gospel' of Caesar the supposed 'good news' that a new emperor had taken the throne, bringing (so he claimed) peace and justice to the world.



Likely some guards shook their heads in disbelief, confident in the superior power of Caesar. Others laughed at Paul's "fairy tale." But perhaps a few went away pondering, seeing something in Paul that they had not seen in a prisoner before. Paul would identify that "something" as Christ.

Philippians 1

12 I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel, 13 so that it has become known throughout the whole imperial guard and to all the rest that my imprisonment is for Christ.



The brothers who are with me greet you. All the saints greet you, especially those of Caesar's household. — Philippians 4:21-22 —

Paul had wanted to go to Rome to preach the Good News of Jesus in the heart of the empire. **God answered Paul's prayers** beyond his wildest of dreams. God is working all things for the good.



Philippians 1

14 And most of the brothers, having become confident in the Lord by my imprisonment, are much more bold to speak the word without fear. Most of the brothers in the Lord have gained confidence from my imprisonment and dare even more to speak the message fearlessly.

Moreover, because of my imprisonment the Lord has caused most of the brothers to become confident to speak God's word more boldly and courageously than ever before.

Wait a minute. **That makes** no sense whatsoever. How is that even possible?





Strangely, seeing Paul in prison for the faith he believed and proclaimed has not had a chilling effect on the Christians in Rome. Rather, they've become more confident and more bold to speak the word without fear.



18 What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed, and in that I rejoice.








The Apostle Paul – 2 Corinthians 5:17-20 (NIV) –


And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.




If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.





No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers,


nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
