
The Fellowship of the Gospel — Philippians 1:3-8

...far greater labors, far more imprisonments, with countless beatings, and often near death. Five times I received at the hands of the Jews the forty lashes less one. Three times I was beaten with rods. Once I was stoned. Three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I was adrift at sea;

on frequent journeys, in danger from rivers, danger from robbers, danger from my own people, danger from Gentiles, danger in the city, danger in the wilderness, danger at sea, danger from false brothers; in toil and hardship, through many a sleepless night, in hunger and thirst, often without food,

Philippians 1

3 I thank my God in all my remembrance of you....

It can be truly said that Christianity is about a personal relationship with God ("my God") though Jesus Christ. But even though it is a personal relationship, it is not a private relationship because it immerses us in the fellowship of the Gospel.



These Philippian saints had entered into "the fellowship of the gospel" with Paul with the mission of spreading the Good News about the world's true Lord & Savior, Jesus.







The Future:


