The Vision and Mission of Metro Life Church

The purpose of articulating Vision and Mission is to bring *clarity* to a local church on its purpose and *structure* the activities that serve the stated purpose. Vision defines the purpose and mission defines how it is carried out. Informed by Scripture, the vision and mission of a local church serves to focus and align people, resources, and responsibilities around a common goal. Vision and mission alone don't accomplish this; nor do they say everything that a church is. But hopefully they do serve to move in the same direction toward a unified goal. The vision of a local church doesn't originate from the church; God has already made plain what we were created for. So our vision is informed by His vision! Our mission is to keep us on track in practical ways with His vision for our lives individually and corporately!

I. Vision Statement

Metro Life Church – Pursuing the glory of God

God is altogether glorious, and His glory is above all things. We join with Moses and believers through the ages with this desire, "Show me your glory!"

But what does glory mean? How do we articulate it? Glory is "making God look good, like he is."

We want to "declare his glory among the nations (Psalm 96:3)." We want to see God's glory over all the earth (Psalm 108:5). We want to grasp that nothing in this life can be compared to the glory that will be revealed to us (Romans 8:18). We want to live everyday aware of the Day when we will appear with him in glory (Colossians 3:4), and we will dwell with God in a city that needs no light, for the glory of God will be its light (Revelation 21:23)!

II. Mission Statement

Loving God finds expression through our commitment to:

Scripture – Scripture is God's gift to us that enables us to know His love and to grow in our love for Him. Therefore, we are devoted to His Word.

Worship –We want to live in such a way that demonstrates we love God and delight to bring Him glory. God's glory permeates all of life and so we live life unto Him.

Discipleship – Loving God creates in us a desire to be like Him. Because we love Him, we follow Him and join with others in helping them do the same.

2. <u>Growing Together</u> – It brings God glory as we become like Christ and God intends for us to grow in Him in relationship with one another.

Growing together finds expression through our commitment to:

Maturity – We encourage and spur one another on in our relationship with Christ. We aim to be a people who are becoming more Christ-like.

Serving – We use our gifts, talents and time to build up the body of Christ. We serve one another as unto the Lord.

3. <u>Proclaiming Christ</u> – God reveals His glory through the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We proclaim Christ through Spirit-filled demonstration and declaration.

Partnership – The New Testament depicts local churches in one community in partnership with local churches in other communities. We partner with other churches near and far to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
