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## While Listening

(Hearers of The Word)

What are we learning about God today?

What am I learning about myself in these Scriptures or through this message?

What's something you heard that you didn't understand?

How can I live differently because of what I've heard?

## Follow Up

(Doers of The Word)

What's something I liked about the message?

After hearing this something I'm going to Thank God for is:

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Where can I change after hearing this?

What's something I want to share with others that I heard?

What issues apply specifically to my friendships, relationships, marriage, family life, workplace, neighbors, etc.?

What about this is important for our church community that the Pastors saw need to address it now?

How can I be a part of supporting the pursuit of New Testament Authenticity that we are called to as a church?

## Bereans

(Meditating on The Word and weighing what we hear rightly)

Who can I talk to about what I don't understand?

What is happening around the passage I heard from that can help me understand the author's meaning?

What do other verses throughout scripture say about this passage? How do they "connect" to it and help me understand?

Are there any passages of scripture that I heard today that I need to meditate on further and/or memorize?

How does what I am learning apply specifically to my season of life, home, workplace, campus or neighbors?

Here are questions that I still have

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Is there a Theological Truth that what we're studying helps me better understand?

How does what we're studying affect my understanding and operating in Spiritual Gifts or Fruit in my life?
