



John writes, “so that you may know that you have eternal life” (1 John 5:13). Why? It is not necessarily because the church was doubting their salvation. Rather, among the real gospel in their community there were false gospels. The church was in danger of being assured in their own minds

while actually being deceived. For example, John says, “I am writing these things to you about those who are trying to deceive you” (1 John 2:26). He mentions deception two other times and two times in 2 John as well.

John writes about the true fellowship with God, who is truly in the light, what true love is, and how we truly know the Spirit of God. There is much more!

- *Jesus and the Old Testament* Led by Brian Wallace - The Old Testament Scriptures spoke of Jesus, but many did not recognize and believe Him when He came. This Block focuses on Old Testament Scriptures that addressed Messiah's location, timing, character and activities and how Jesus was the fulfillment of these Scriptures.
- *The Gospel and Sexual Ethics* Led by Pastors Nathan and Alex- How are Christians to think and live in an over-sexualized culture? This Block is to help clear through the cultural fog and understand the truth of God's word in a way that helps us live in holiness and love.
- *How to Study the bible (Women's Group)* Led by Stephanie Lindsey - A Block specifically for women to give you the tools to open any passage in God's word, look at the facts of the passage, see attributes of God and most importantly apply the truths to our lives.

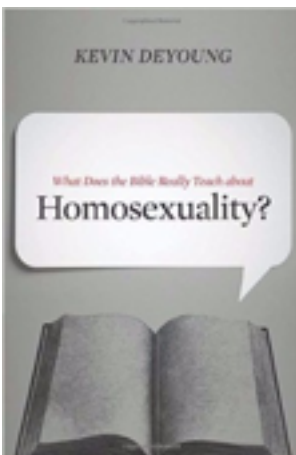
