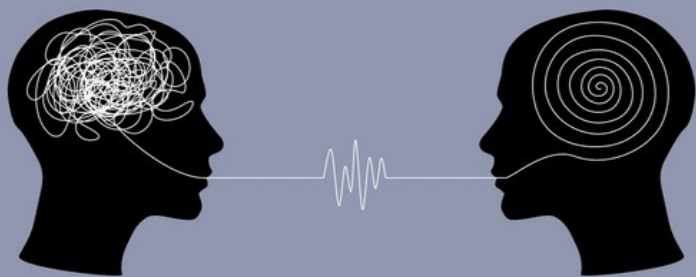


What Do You Say When . . .
