hardness of heart Moses allowed you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so.

And I say to you: whoever divorces his wife,

except for sexual immorality, and marries another,

commits adultery."

**People:** The disciples said to him, "If such is the case of a

man with his wife, it is better not to marry."

Leader: But he said to them, "Not everyone can receive

this saying, but only those to whom it is given. For there are eunuchs who have been so from birth, and there are eunuchs who have been made eunuchs by men, and there are eunuchs who have

made themselves eunuchs for the sake of the

kingdom of heaven.

**People:** Let the one who is able to receive this receive it."

Leader: Heavenly Father, Forgive us. For we have sinned. In

Your wisdom, You designed the intricate dance of two genders to harmonize, a symphony for our mutual flourishing and Your divine glory. In Your created design, You ordained the sacred covenant of

Leader: Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the

and without blemish.

HEAR THE WORD OF THE LORD

SERMON PASSAGE Genesis 2:18-25 ESV

Then the Lord God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him." Now out of the ground the Lord God had formed every beast of the field and every bird of the heavens and brought them to the man to see what he would call them.
