BUILDING FUND

Dear MAPC Family,

The Building Team has identified several important projects to maintain and enhance our church building and grounds. These improvements for supporting our ministry are estimated to cost approximately \$52k.

To fund these efforts, the Deacons have proposed, and the Session has approved, a two-part plan:

1. \$26k from MAPC's \$106k reserve, leaving \$80k in reserve fund
2. \$26k from a **building fund** raised by the congregation

*The **building fund** will be a designated line item separate from the 2025 church budget. If you feel led to contribute, we kindly ask that your gifts to the building fund be in addition to your regular giving toward the church's general budget. For clarity, please clearly mark your checks "Building Fund" if you choose to give in this way.*

We are deeply grateful for your generosity and continued partnership as we steward the facilities God has entrusted to us for His glory.

Funds will go toward items like:

1. Gutter repair
2. Sound system improvements
3. Playground equipment
4. Stained glass windows in lobby
5. Interior painting & woodwork
6. Other beautification projects
