- As Christians, how can we connect the truths we've learned from this section of God's Word and faithfully communicate them to a non-believer? What key points would you focus on, and how would you guide them toward the Gospel?"
- Mill Creek, how can this text guide our church community and foster a positive impact on our local body? Considering our whole church, What does an appropriate response look like in reference to the Scripture and sermon?

Application Questions:

- What does it look like in your life right now to teach your kids, family, or friends that salvation is here, that we are called to turn from evil, and that Jesus was sacrificed so we could be redeemed? How are you going to do this?
- What does it look like to 'kill' the sin in your life? And how can we pursue this in the context of our church community
