- Read through the sermon outline together.

### **Discussion Questions:**

- Is there anything you learned in this passage that seemed new to you?
- How does this passage better inform your understanding of who God is?
- How do the truths revealed about God in these passages help shape the way believers should live in light of the Gospel? Explain.
- As Christians, how can we connect the truths we've learned from this section of God's Word and faithfully communicate them to a non-believer? What key points would you focus on, and how would you guide them toward the Gospel?
- Mill Creek, how can this text guide our church community and foster a positive impact on our local body? Considering our whole church, What does an appropriate response look like in reference to the Scripture and sermon?

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### **Application Questions:**

- The sermon identifies three common substitutes that often rule instead of Christ's peace: fake peace, frustration, and fractures. Which of these three have you seen most often in church life (or even in your own heart), and why is it so easy to let it take over?
- Gospel root produces the gospel fruit of peace among us. How does remembering the cross—our own forgiveness and reconciliation with God—change the way we handle frustrations, differences, or non-essential disagreements in the church?
